## Item A - Discussion and Resolution Regarding 2015 Annual Financial Statement:

Councilor (Mrs.) Poelstra noted that the Mayor is required to review and note any concerns or inconsistencies. Mayor Richter noted publicly that the profit and loss report passed with flying colors. The report needs to be adopted by resolution as prepared if approved by the Council.
