## CITY OF EDNA BAY, ALASKA RESOLUTION NO. 2015-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF EDNA BAY REQUESTING THE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES DIVISION OF MINING, LAND & WATER AND THE DIVISION OF FORESTRY EXCLUDE THE 113 ACRES OF LAND INDENTIFIED AS SETTLEMENT FROM THE EDNA BAY PARLAY TIMBER SALE AS THE NEWLY FORMED CITY IS STILL FINALIZING ITS MUNICIPAL ENTITLEMENT SELECTION.

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska granted Edna Bay city status for meeting the sustained needs of the residents to meet current and future service and growth needs through maximum self-government; and

WHEREAS, for the City of Edna Bay to meet current and future needs of government, residents, and businesses the city needs adequate entitlement lands of sufficient volume; and

WHEREAS, the City of Edna Bay deliberately established its boundaries to include the 113 acres identified in the Edna Bay Parlay Timber Sale as Settlement due to the land designation of industrial for future development needs; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Edna Bay Parlay Timber Sale will severely restrict the municipal entitlement pool and mire the city in an economic and managerial crisis that will stifle growth potential and the ability of the city to meet its needs; and

**WHEREAS,** the proposed Edna Bay Parlay Timber Sale stands to critically impact the future viability of the city by including the only lands within the city limits designated for industrial development; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the City of Edna Bay formally requests the Department of Natural Resources Division of Mining, Land & Water, and the Division of Forestry exclude the 113 acres of land identified in the Edna Bay Parlay Timber Sale as Settlement as the newly formed city is still finalizing its municipal entitlement selection.
