A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF EDNA BAY AUTHORIZING A SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCE REIMBURSEMENT FOR MATERIALS USED TO CONSTRUCT ROAD ACCESS FOR LOCAL PROPERTY OWNERS.

WHEREAS, The City of Edna Bay is a recognized second class city; and

WHEREAS, second class cities are granted road authority under AS 19.30.241; and

WHEREAS, Richard Stockdale and Maureen Viera, local property owners, approached the city council in November of 2015 regarding an extension to Alcoa Lane, a platted street within the Edna Bay subdivision, to gain access to their property; and

WHEREAS, the newly formed city was in the process of developing its municipal code and not legally prepared to undertake the contracting necessary to provide for access at that time; and

WHEREAS, the property owners approached the city in advance of any construction with a request for access and provided a detailed proposal of work to the city council that was accepted with unanimous approval; and

WHEREAS, Richard and Maureen accepted responsibility for all construction costs incurred for the work described in the proposal;

WHEREAS, the property owners have since submitted a request for reimbursement and provided a receipt for the materials used to extend Alcoa Lane to their property; and

WHEREAS, the circumstances surrounding this reimbursement are a one-time event due to the timing and limited ability of the city to respond to the request for extension of Alcoa Lane; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDNA BAY, ALASKA:

That the City of Edna Bay has agreed in good faith to a special circumstance reimbursement of \$2,016.20 to Richard Stockdale and Maureen Viera for materials used to construct the extension of Alcoa Lane to their driveway.
