

CONTRACT MODIFICATIONS

1) Modification: No. 1 AMENDED

Effective Date: 05/30/2017 Revision Date: 06/24/2017

a) Refer to Section 13A for clarification of revised closing date:

“13A. SEALED OFFERS:

1) Sealed offers in original and one copies to perform work required are due at the following; (Date) Thursday, June 29th, (Location) Edna Bay School, (Time) 6:00PM. If this is a sealed bid, offers will be publicly opened at that time. Sealed envelopes containing offers shall be marked to show the offerors name and address, the Solicitation Number, and the Date and the Time the Offers are due.”

“E.1. Instructions for Preparation of Proposals

Proposals shall be prepared in accordance EBMC Title 4, Section 17.080.

E.2. Instructions for Delivery of Proposals

Sealed offers in original and one copies to perform work required are due at the following; (Date) Thursday, June 29th, (Location) Edna Bay School, (Time) 6:00PM. If this is a sealed bid, offers will be publicly opened at that time. Sealed envelopes containing offers shall be marked to show the offerors name and address, the Solicitation Number, and the Date and the Time the Offers are due.”

E.3. Evaluation Factors for Award

Evaluation factors for award will be conducted in accordance with EBMC Title 4, Section 17.

E.4. Changes and Addenda, Application

No official or officer of the City shall make any oral interpretations that may effect the substance of the contract documents. Addenda will be issued to all bidders when questions arise which might affect the bids. The clerk shall deliver the addendum by certified mail, via email or by hand delivery with a written receipt obtained.

E.5. Post Award Conference

A post award or pre-work conference with the successful offeror is required. It will be scheduled within a reasonable time after award and prior to the issuing of a Notice to Proceed.

E.6. Contract Administration

All matters related to the performance of this contract shall be coordinated through the City Project Manager.

E.7. Insurance Requirements

Contractor shall have in place, at its sole expense, and at all times during the term of the contract the following policies of insurance:

- d) Worker's Compensation - Alaska state law requires that most employers have Worker's Compensation Insurance for their employees. The City of Edna Bay furnishes contact award information to the Alaska Department of Labor. Failure to comply with the State Worker's Compensation Law's can be a felony offense in Alaska. For the definitions of "employer," "employee," and "subcontractor," rates of compensation, and other pertinent information contact:

- e) Liability Insurance – Comprehensive (Commercial) General Liability Insurance with coverage limits not less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) combined single limit per occurrence and annual aggregate where generally applicable; including premise operations, independent contractors, products /completed operations, broad form property damage, blanket contractual, and personal injury and pollution liability endorsements. Contractor shall list the City of Edna Bay as additional insured.
- f) Automobile Liability – Covering all vehicles used in project work with combined single limits no less than \$1,000,000.00 each occurrence.

All of the above insurance coverage shall be considered to be primary and non contributory to any other insurance carried by the City of Edna Bay, whether self insurance or otherwise.

E.8. Current Prevailing Rates of Wage and Employment Preference

When State Funds are utilized, "Little Davis Bacon," is required. For projects that are State funded, contractors are also required to use local residents where they are available and qualified in accordance with AS 36.10.150-180, and 8 AAC 30.064 - 088.

- b) *To the extent required by Federal and State law construction projects may require contractors to pay minimum rates of pay for specific classes of workers and provide certified payrolls to the State Department of Labor. E.9. Declaration of Suspension and Debarment

The offeror, and or any of its principals, attests they are not presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, or declared ineligible for the award of contract by any Federal agency.

E.10. Inspection of Construction

- *Daily inspection of construction activities will be performed by the Project Manager.*
- *Contractor will comply with the requirements of data collection and provide a report to the Project Manager upon request.*

E.11. Acceptance

Upon completion of the designated contract items, a final inspection will be performed by the City Project Manager. Following satisfactory review, a statement will be issued to the contractor that all work is complete. The contractor may then submit an invoice to the City for payment. Payment will be issued within 30 days."

4) Modification: No. 4

Effective Date: 06/24/2017

The following language replaces **Section A.1 – Scope of Contract**:

"A.1. Scope of Contract:

This contract will be carried out in three phases:

Phase one will consist of electrical ditching around the facility as depicted in Attachment B, Edna Bay BFU project IFC 08-30-2016. Ditching will be overseen by City Project Manager with inspection/direction by Electrical Contractor.

Phase two the Contractor will provide equipment and labor to unload barge of all Edna Bay Bulk Fuel Facility tanks and equipment.

Phase three will be to move and place tanks and equipment for the BFF. Plans, drawings and associated documents that relate to the project are detailed below in A.3. - Attachments to Statement of Work/Specifications. Phase three consists of providing for 3 (three) cement pads for the mounting of spill containers located on the tank bulkheads. The three pads will be 3'x3'x4' above grade.

Contractor should communicate in writing, by attaching to their bid the requested info in attachment F, that they have the ability and equipment capable to move and place all BFF components.

It is the contractors responsibility to be familiar with the plans and changes to the plans. Contractor should contact City Project Manager with any questions prior to placing their bid."

5) Modification: No. 5

Effective Date: 06/24/2017

Clarifications and Additions:

"Yellow cedar may be substituted for the pressure treated lumber and must meet the following specifications:

Rough cut 6" x 6" x 12' timbers must be sound, no shake, no rot, solid knots no larger than 2.5". Timbers to be coated with application of wood sealer and water repellent prior to assembly. Timbers dressed to S4S standards (Surfaced 4 Sides) not required. Timbers to be inspected and approved by City Project Manager prior to installation.

Fastener quantity and size for timber construction will be 1/2"x8" and 5/connection row. A change to the connection specification in Section 06130 part 3(c)(1) shall be to keep same direction of insertion, but offset each line of connections rather than to install with same orientation. If stainless steel fasteners are used, grade 18-8, type 304 or Type 316 are acceptable. Other grades may be acceptable, but must first be approved by the City Project Manager."
