This application is for commercial operations on parcels larger than 40 acres, which will be utilizing roads outside of the timber harvest area for transportation with vehicles having a GVW rating over 20,000 lbs. in excess of two vehicles per day, or 10 vehicles in a one-calendar-week period, whichever is more.

<sup>\*</sup>Please note that as per Municipal code 6.50, the TSP serves as the basis for determining the requirements to be included in the timber transportation permit:

- 1. identify topics and issues to be discussed at regular truck driver safety meetings;
- 2. identify hauling time-period limitations that may be necessary for traffic safety or noise abatement;
- 3. identify vehicle operator actions such as reduced speed where road conditions or other uses warrant; and
- 4. identify the means of public information to be taken by the person to notify the public about timber harvest plan of operations and mitigating actions that will be taken in the traffic safety plan.

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## OWNER'S AND/OR AUTHORIZED AGENT'S STATEMENT: I am owner/agent of the following property slated for harvest: and, I hereby accept the conditions of this Timber Transport Permit (TTP) in accordance with applicable municipal code for the property described in this application. I understand all activity must be conducted in compliance with the Alaska Forest Resources and Practices Act (FRPA) that governs how timber harvesting, reforestation, and timber access occur on state, private, and municipal land. Forest management standards on federal land must also meet or exceed the standards established by the FRPA for state land. I understand that all timber harvest activity related to this application must be conducted in compliance with CEB 6.50. I understand that other rules such as local, state and federal regulations, covenants, plat notes and deed restrictions may be applicable and other permits or authorization may be required. I understand that the Council may also impose conditions and safeguards designed to protect the public's health, safety and welfare related to the safety transportation of harvested timber or timber harvest products. I acknowledge that a pre-work inspection of roads on the route and a post inspection to identify any damage will be required, and that I may be responsible to repair any material damage. I understand that the any significant changes to the (TTP) may be amended by written notice to the Council of the City of Edna Bay for determination if a new public notice shall be required. Any significant changes without notification will result in suspension or revocation of the (TTP). I acknowledge that I have received a copy of Chap 6.50 -Timber Harvest and that I have read and understand the conditions of the application and permit procedures.
