Narrative Portion of the Edna Bay Development Plan

This project is located within Land Estate Section 23, Township 68S, Range 76E of Copper River Meridian Alaska. I think the only way to provide a detailed legal description will have to be after the survey since it is a portion of an existing right of way located in Section 23.

The terrain is relatively flat covered mostly with small second growth spruce, hemlock, cedar and berry bushes.

There are no buildings or other structures located within the proposed area.

There is no power sources located within the proposed area.

There is no waste or waste sources located within the proposed area.

There are no hazardous substances located within the proposed area other than the petroleum products that will be used in the machines to construct the supply lines and several times per year when petroleum products travel through the transfer lines during the process of a fuel delivery.

There is no water supply or waste water to be disposed of.

There is a small area (dirt base, no concrete, approx. 40' wide) used for public parking that the buried fuel lines will be buried under from one side to the other.

The number of people using the site will be a maximum of 3 Edna Bay Bulk Fuel Facility employees. It is yet unknown the ratio of supervisor/staff. No clients will be using the site.

The buried fuel lines will be maintained by Edna Bay Bulk Fuel Facility employees on a maintenance schedule to be determined in the development plan by the AEA. No subcontractors will be utilized.

In the effect the this permit was revoked or expired, the pipeline would be removed and the ground would be shoveled and raked back to its original state as much as possible and any bare ground planted with a natural grass mix.
